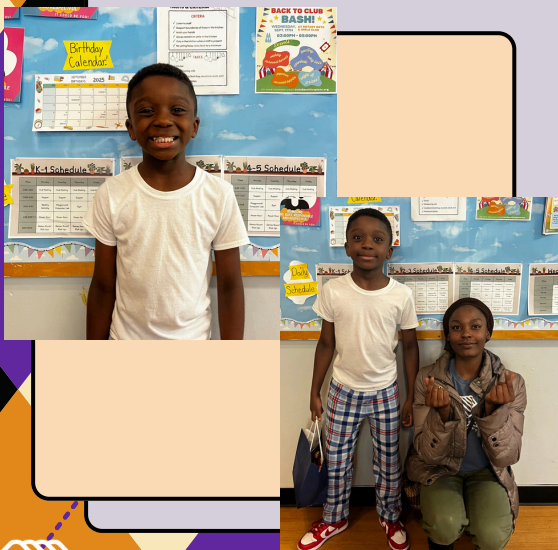
2-3 JACKSON FENDALL
